Current ILD Zone Districts and CN Zone participants do NOT need to reapply, those participants are automatically included in the SRSN for the 2023-24 school year. You will be asked later in the summer to update participant contact information.

Current ILDZ districts are highly encouraged to consider participating in the SDZ Cohort 2. This group of districts will engage in the Demonstration Project and submit a second waiver request to the State Board of Education. This Demonstration Project will build on the work started with SDZ Cohort 1.
